(Scheduled on 26 June, adjourned on 27 June 2020)

In reference to the circular of Govt. of Maharashtra dated 15.06.2020 and letter of Deputy EO, Primary, dated 23.06.2020





AS PER ORDERS OF HON. COMMISSIONER, NMC, WE NEED TO CONDUCT EPTA MEET REGARDING,

- Opening of school
- Online classes / Digital Education from Std 3 onwards
- School fees and discount/waiver in school fees
- Sanitization of School Building
- Social distancing at school and in Auto/Van/Bus
- Joining dates of teaching/ non-teaching staff
- Any other issues on prior Approval of Chairperson of PTA.





START OF AC YR 2020-21

- School of **Std 9, 10, 12** will start from **1 July 2020.**
- School of Std 6 to 8 will start from 1 August 2020.
- School of Std 3 to 5 will start from 1 September 2020.
- For **Std 1 and 2**, it is not declared by government and guidelines have been given that TV, radio etc. should be used for home schooling till the opening of schools. Hence it is being decided that on safer side, **Std 1** and **2 shall start in second term** i.e. from **1**st of **Dec**, **2020**.
- For Std. 3 to 8, EPTA has received requests from many parents that they do not want to send their wards at least up to the end of First Term i.e. 30 November 2020. Considering Corona outbreak it is resolved that the schooling for Std. 1 to 8 will start from 1st of Dec, 2020.
- The schooling, if required will be **extended up to May end,** preferably in morning hours (to avoid scorching sun) so as to complete the syllabus and activities.
- Govt. Deeksha App shall be promoted among all students.
- The govt. policy of "Shaala nahi pan shikshan ahe" be implemented. Hence online education / web based e-learning (from class 3 onwards) be provided from June 2020.





START OF CLASSROOM EDUCATION

- As per Govt of Maharashtra circular dated 15.06.2020, the students can report in classroom/ school only in case of ZERO COVID patients in last 30 days.
- If the number of COVID patients keep on increasing, the school won't reopen and only online/digital education will be continued for Std 3 and onwards.





JOINING OF TEACHERS AND PAYMENT OF SALARIES

- For facilitation of Online Education, the necessary teaching staff be called on duty.
- Teachers for **Std 1 and 2**, will be called only when students will be allowed to report in classroom.
- The salary to the teachers will be payable from their respective date of joining.





JOINING OF NON TEACHING STAFF

- Office and admin staff should be employed for all 12 months.
- Peons and other non-teaching staff members should be called as per actual requirement especially of sanitization.
- The school management/ H.M. shall have all powers to reduce/increase staff members.





ONLINE CLASSES/DIGITAL EDUCATION FROM GRADE 3 ONWARDS

- As per GOM circular dated 15.06.2020, GOM is going to issue standard operating procedure (SOP)
- > Std 3-5: Not more than 1 hour daily
- > Std 6-8: Not more than 2 hrs daily
- > Std 9 onwards: Not more than 3 hours daily
- Although the digital learning/teaching is for limited period but the duty hours of the teacher(s) will be as per regular school hours. Teacher will be available for online doubt session for the students during regular school timing.
- Special assignments/homework will be given and students should submit the assignment through online mode OR students/parents will drop the solved assignments in school office for due checking by the teachers.

WAIVERS IN SCHOOL FEES

- The fees for Std. 9 and 10 will be charged from June 2020 as per Resolution No. 6 i.e. Rs. 36,000.
- Std 1 to 8 shall start in second term i.e. from 1st of Dec, 2020 hence Tuition fee from June 2020 to November 2020 (@ Rs. 3000 per month, totalling to Rs. 15,000) will be waived off. However the First Term Fee Rs. 3000 will be charged to meet the administration expenses. Hence out of total fees of Rs. 36,000 for Academic Year 2020-21, Rs. 15,000 will be waived off and balance Rs. 21,000 will be charged per student. This waiver is applicable only if school starts on or after 1 December 2020. No further waiver in fees will be granted on any ground. If in case the school starts before 1st December 2020, then Tuition fee will be applicable / chargeable from that particular month. It is specifically resolved that the aforesaid fee can be paid monthly / quarterly / one time as per the choice of parent. However the cut off date for promotion in higher class (Ac. Yr. 20-21) shall be 15 July 2020. Thereafter the school management will have the authority to struck off the name of the student from school rolls. It is further resolved that, this fee waiver is strictly applicable for Ac. Yr. 2020-21 and from next Ac. Yr. 2021-22, the regular Tuition fee @ Rs. 3000 per month along-with Term Fee per term Rs. 3000 totalling to Rs. 36,000 will be charged as per Resolution No. 6
- The school management may grant concession/ discount/ rebate/ free gifts on case to case basis.



SANITIZATION OF SCHOOL BUILDING

- School management and staff members will take due care of sanitization.
- Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) will be strictly followed.
- Before physical opening of school, the parents and/or students will be required to sign Terms and Conditions for Social Distancing and Safety on account of COVID-19.





SOCIAL DISTANCING AT SCHOOL AND IN AUTO/VAN/BUS

- 1. As per GOM circular dated 15.06.2020: One student on one bench and schooling hours will be
- > Std 3-5: 2 hours schooling
- > Std 6 onwards: 3 hours schooling
- > # If needed alternate days school.
- > # Supported by digital education (if needed).
- 2. One student in one auto/rikshaw. If coming by bus/van then one student on one seat.

 OR
- 3. Parent to drop and pick their ward by personal vehicle.
